Cash Tickets

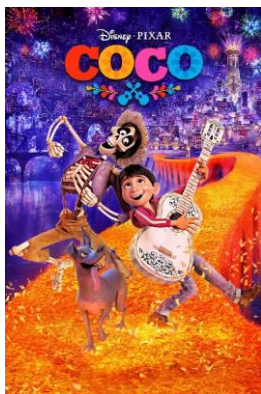

Movie Night!



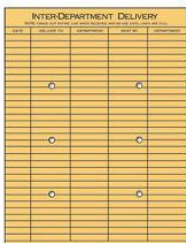
Celebrate All Souls' Day by seeing a movie that shows how another culture celebrates it!
