

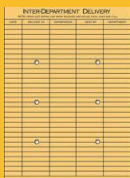

Music News

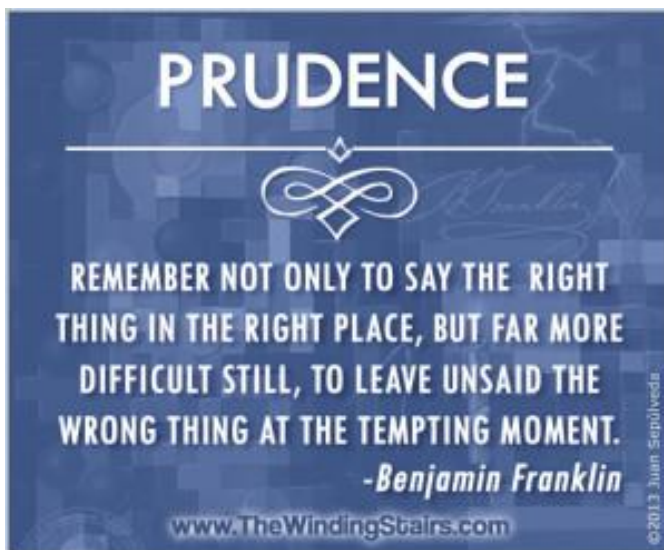
