

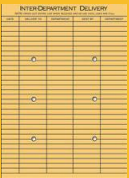

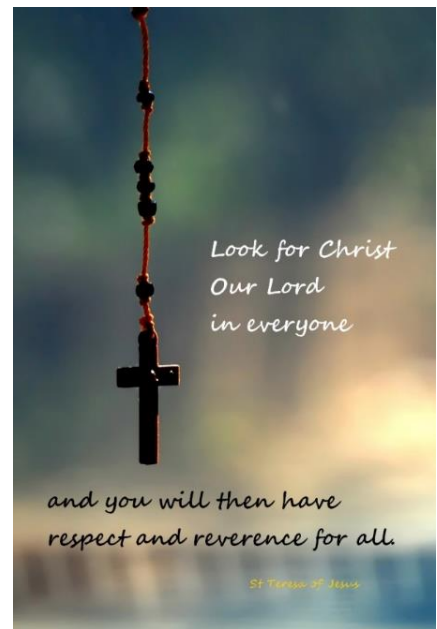

## Security Alert – Fake Fundraising Campaigns

Over the past several weeks, non-profit organizations around the country have been reporting a troubling new wave of scams. Scammers have taken to creating very convincing false fundraising campaigns in order to steal from well-meaning individuals. These scams especially hit home for organizations like ours during this time of giving.

The scammers steal logos from their target and use them along with a convincing appeal and fake GoFundMe template to trick people into donating to a PayPal account that is operated by the scammers.

If you receive a message like this from our organization or any other, please be certain to verify the validity of the message before considering a donation. If you are unsure about the validity of a fundraising campaign message, please feel free to contact the Main Office.

It has also been reported to us that “Spoofers” have taken our phone number in order to trick people into answering the phone. Please be aware that the school will never ask for money over the phone. You can always call the Main Office if you have any questions.
