

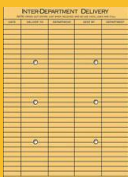

## ACT Testing



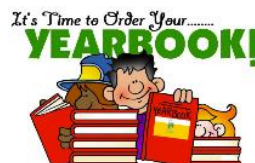

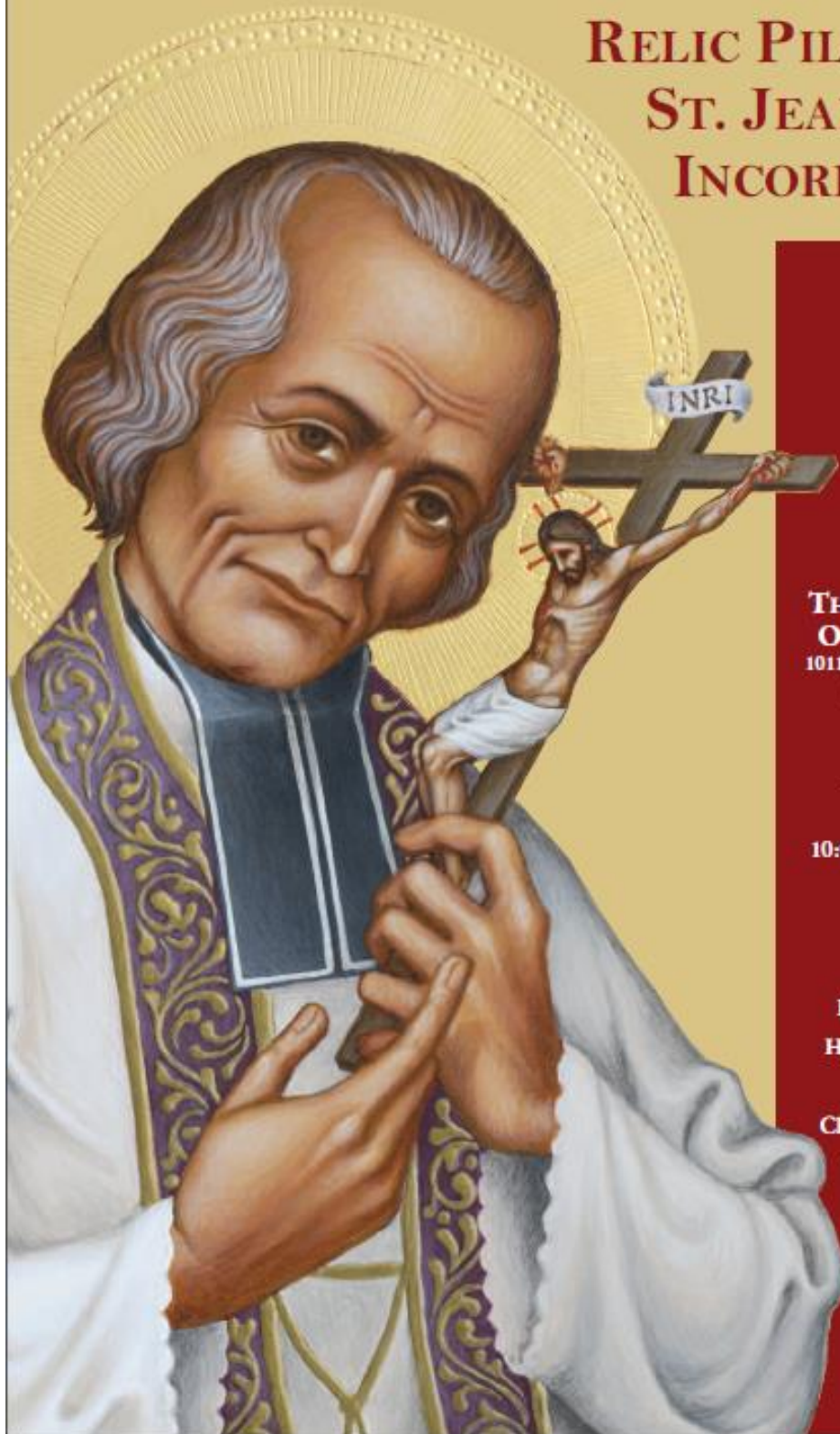
