Recommendations for Individuals Who Test Positive for COVID-19	
Everyone, regardless of vaccination status:	Stay home for 5 days.
	If the person with COVID-19 either has no symptoms or has resolved or improving symptoms (including no fever) after Day 5, the person may leave the house provided they wear a well-fitting mask when around other people for 5 additional days. Day 0 is defined as either the date of symptom onset, or the date the test specimen was collected if the person is asymptomatic.
	If someone develops symptoms consistent with COVID-19, testing is recommended regardless of vaccination or prior infection status.
	If fever persists or other symptoms have not improved after 5 days, the person should wait to end isolation until symptoms have improved and fever has resolved.

Individuals Exposed to Someone with COVID-19	
If you: Had confirmed COVID-19 within the last 90 days as diagnosed by a viral test OR *Are 18 or older and have received ALL of the recommended vaccine doses and additional primary shots if immunocompromised OR Are 5-17 years old and have completed the primary series of COVID-19 vaccines *Heterologous (mix-and-match) dosing may occur for the booster dose.	Quarantine is not required.
	Wear a mask around others for 10 days from the date of the last close contact with someone with COVID-19
	Get tested at least 5 days after the last close contact, if possible. If symptoms develop or if the test is positive, follow the recommendations for individuals who test positive.
If you: Are unvaccinated OR Over 18 and completed the primary series of Pfizer or Moderna vaccine OVER 6 months ago and are not boosted OR Received the single-dose J&J vaccine over 2 months ago and have not received a recommended booster OR Have not completed the primary vaccine series	If someone develops symptoms, consistent with COVID-19, testing is recommended regardless of vaccination status.
	Stay home for 5 days.
	After that, continue to wear a mask around others for 5 additional days.
	Test on day 5 if possible. If positive, follow the recommendations above for individuals who test positive.
Monitor for symptoms, including fever (100.4 or greater). If symptoms develop, get tested and isolate until results are received. If someone in your family has symptoms and is being tested, please stay home until test results are received. This can help prevent the spread of COVID.	

Guidance for Students When Household Member Tests Positive for COVID

If the student is not vaccinated:	She/he will need to quarantine for the same period of time as the person who is COVID positive has to quarantine if family member cannot isolate. Following this quarantine period, the exposed family member must quarantine for another 5 days.
	If family member with COVID-19 can isolate from other family members, the close contact's 5 day quarantine period would start from the last time they were exposed to the person with COVID-19.
	Should the student test positive at any point during the quarantine she/he must follow the updated guidelines for testing positive.
If the student is vaccinated:	She/he is permitted to attend school but must wear a mask for 10 days from the date of exposure.
