Virtual Auction: Feb 27-March 5

- Again this year, PTF representatives are asked to coordinate a themed basket or “experience” package that will be used for this online event. The school will send out further details to all reps and provide an email template explaining the event which can be sent to families. The items should be delivered to the school by February 20 because we need to take pictures and post these on the auction website in advance. Reps are asked to please alert the office about ideas so we can communicate out and avoid duplicate suggestions. We are also interested in procuring donations from local businesses and similarly ask that the office be informed in advance of any solicitation so we may avoid visiting the same business multiple times.

Gym Uniforms

- We discussed the idea of students wearing a standard gym uniform. The group expressed that a uniform would be preferable to having gym in the standard uniform and felt parents would be willing to pay an additional expense for this change. Some asked if students would be able to change into/out of the uniform. Mr. Frye had concerns about the loss of time in doing so. Mother of Sorrows and some other schools were cited as having a gym uniform and Mr. Frye pledged to reach out for a copy of their procedures. One parent noted that in another school the gym uniform consisted of a prescribed T-shirt but students had flexibility on the athletic bottoms, as long as they were all black. Mr. Frye is considering a pilot program this year for Logic School.

Dress Down for Pegasus and Orion

- The house of Pegasus won last year’s House Cup but did not receive the award of a dress down day. That day has been assigned to Friday, January 28th. (NOTE: Mr. Frye gave January 21st as the day during the meeting, but this had to be changed.) NOTE2: The house of Orion will ALSO receive a dress down day on the 28th as a reward for donating the most items during this year’s canned food drive.

Playground

- Updates were given on this committee’s work. Possible site locations have been reviewed with one new location waiting for approval from Holy Family Parish. The next step will be to look for possible equipment and designs to fit the chosen space.

Strategic Plan

- In recognition of CDT's 30th anniversary, the school will be writing a 5-year strategic plan. The first steps will be an upcoming survey and focus group with local constituents. These will take place over the next six weeks, with the actual goal-setting and writing of the plan to follow.

Re-enrollment/Open House

- Catholic Schools Week begins on Sunday, January 30th. This is the week we traditionally begin enrolling new students for next year. Right now, our current parents have the first opportunity to re-enroll and secure spots for next year. Additionally, reps are asked to remind parents about our referral program wherein in current parents can have their tuition lowered if someone they recommend ends up attending CDT.
